- Encourage employees to submit proposals that result in minimizing the negative environmental impact our operations can have.

- Report and analyse environmental incidents, identify root causes and action implementation.

- 12. Comply with legislation and regulatory requirements where ever we work.
- 13. Carry out audits and inspections on iSURVEY Group work sites and sub-contractor facilities as applicable.
